#### **OPERATION ART COMPETITION REMINDER**

Wyoming Public School is holding a school-wide Operation Art Competition again this year. The competition is open to all students K-6. Artworks must be 2D (no sculptures). Minimum size for artworks is A4 (30X21cm) and maximum size is A2 (42x60cm). A variety of mediums may be used to create the artworks including pencils, crayons, ink, paint, charcoal and collage. In addition to students creating artworks outside of school hours, each teacher will nominate two artworks created in their class to be part of the competition.

Artworks are to be submitted to Mrs McCredie by Friday 17 May 2024 (Term 2, Week 3). During Week 4 every student will have the opportunity to vote for their favourite K-2 and 3-6 artwork.

Student's Choice: Students will vote for their favourite artwork and the most popular artwork from the K-2 and 3-6 categories will be presented with a certificate and an art supplies pack.

Don't forget the winning artworks that will go on display at the Children's Hospital are selected for the purpose of brightening the lives of sick and injured children.

#### **OPPORTUNITY CLASS 2025**

(YEAR 4 STUDENTS 2024)

Opportunity classes are just one of the ways that we can support our high potential and gifted students. These classes are offered in Years 5 and 6, with parents/carers applying when their child is in Year 4.

Opportunity classes provide an environment where students can learn and make friends with classmates of similar abilities. This can benefit students' academic progress and wellbeing. There are 86 primary schools with opportunity classes in NSW and two opportunity classes at Gosford and Wyong Public Schools on the Central Coast. You can apply outside your local area as opportunity classes are not zoned.

Applications for opportunity class placement are considered on the results of the Opportunity Class Placement Test. Students who wish to be considered for placement are required to sit the Opportunity Class Placement Test on **Thursday 1 August 2024**.
