NAPLAN Results

All students in Years 3 and 5 will have received their NAPLAN results for 2018. We are in the process of completing a full analysis of results however at initial look these results confirm the great work that our staff and students are completing every day.

Across all areas Wyoming is performing at or above the average of schools with similar enrolments and in the area of Year 5 reading we have outperformed the average of all schools in NSW – an exceptional outcome!

As always we use these results to form part of the overall “picture” of your child’s strengths or areas for improvement. If you would like to discuss your child’s individual results please feel free to contact the classroom teacher for an appointment time.
