NAPLAN Results

All students in Years 3 and 5 will have received their NAPLAN results for 2018. We are in the process of completing a full analysis of results however at initial look these results confirm the great work that our staff and students are completing every day.

Across all areas Wyoming is performing at or above the average of schools with similar enrolments and in the area of Year 5 reading we have outperformed the average of all schools in NSW – an exceptional outcome!



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
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
