#### Ethics Classes

#### Kiss and Drop

In the coming weeks, we will be receiving new parking signs for Veronica Crescent. What is now known as the 'kiss and drop' zone will be changed to a '1, 2, 3' stop. This means that **1 car** can stop for **2 minutes** and the driver cannot be more than **3 metres** away from the vehicle. This will allow parents to help their children exit the vehicle on the footpath side and retrieve school bags. It will not allow for parents to park their car and enter the school grounds.
