

PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

Hello to all,



Term 1 has been a very busy term for your children and I would like to extend my sincere congratulations for the manner in which they have approached the 2019 school year.

Moving into Term 2, our focus will be to strengthen the fostering of independence and to build confidence in student knowledge of school routines. For this reason I kindly ask that you say your goodbyes to your little one prior to having them sit in lines at morning assembly. Following the assembly we ask that parents do not follow students to the classrooms but remain in the assembly area to exit the school by the most appropriate path.

Similarly it is time to give a gentle reminder that parents are not to go directly to classrooms during learning time. If your little one has forgotten lunch or asked you to drop something in during the day please enter the school via the front office where your child will be called to collect.

Last of all please be aware that the A block basement area is at times used by classes for lessons – we kindly request that parents do not wait for students within this area until after the 2.45pm bell.

Your support in these routines is greatly appreciated.

Watch Out – Whooping Cough is About

Whooping cough (also called pertussis) began increasing across NSW towards the end of 2018, especially in children between the ages of 5 and 14 years. NSW Health anticipates that this increase will continue into 2019.

School-aged children who are infected with whooping cough usually experience a troubling cough that can persist for months, but they rarely get severe illness. However they can spread the infection to younger siblings and other more vulnerable people, who are at higher risk of severe disease. Whooping cough can be life threatening to babies.

What can you do to prevent whooping cough?

- Make sure vaccinations are up to date for all family members
- 2. Be alert for symptoms of whooping cough
- 3. Keep coughing kids at home, to prevent them spreading the infection to others, and see your GP to get them tested for whooping cough.



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

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
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
