I'd like to begin this newsletter by thanking all of you. As usual, the Wyoming community has shown great support for our school by keeping children at home where possible and following the huge amount of ever-changing information and directives. The plan for the rest of Term 2 is outlined below.

Week 2 – the school remains open to those people who need it. This includes children of essential workers. These students are supervised only and continue to work on the prepared packages of learning.

The instructions from the NSW Department of Education is to keep our attendance to about 25%. This will ensure we can maintain appropriate social distancing measures. We can only achieve this with your support-it's important to follow the guidelines as provided and continue to learn from home four days per week if possible-only coming to school on the day we have organised. While this is inconvenient, it will mean a quicker return to normal school attendance.

PARENT ACCESS

Parents are asked to pick up and drop off students outside the school gates rather than coming onto school grounds. Please use the drop off area in Veronica Close and the front gate to drop students in the morning and then pick up will be from the front gate only. From next Tuesday 12 May, I will be bringing the students out in year groups in order to minimise the amount of parents we have at any one time.

Every school has been asked to restrict parents coming onto school grounds to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19. Community cooperation to assist the school to minimise risk by sending emails or making phone calls to contact teachers is greatly appreciated.

LEARNING PACKAGES

It's really important for our students to get into the habit of carrying their learning packages to and from school. This will be especially important if for any reason the school has to reduce attendance suddenly. I know this is tricky for our younger students-please utilise the Books in Homes bags-they already have the students' names clearly marked on the front.

STAFF

This is a reminder to our families that teachers are working both at home and at school. The roster is set on a weekly basis to ensure there is enough staff at school to supervise the children but not so many we can't socially distance. If you email the school with a question for the teacher, this will be forwarded to them ASAP. However, they may not always be able to get back to you immediately.


