#### Afternoon Collection

Thank you for your patience while we iron out the afternoon collection procedures. Under our new process's students will be available from the hall at the following times:

- 2.35pm Kindergarten with their siblings
- 2.40pm Stage 1 (Year 1 and 2) with their siblings
- 2.45pm Stage 2 (Year 3 and 4) with their siblings.

If you wish to collect your child from a location outside of school grounds (e.g. across the road in the Maidens Brush Park) or if your child walks / rides their bike home of an afternoon they will be dismissed from class at 2.45pm and leave the school via the top bus gate.

Students in Stage 3 (Years 5 and 6) will be dismissed from class at 2.45pm and leave the school grounds via the top bus gate – there is no need for parents of students in Stage 3 to come to the hall.
