COVID Safe Guidelines

A core part of our COVID Safe guidelines is keeping students in cohort groups. This is to minimise the opportunity for transmission of COVID-19 between student groups.

At Wyoming we have arranged cohorts by stage (Kindergarten, Stage 1, Stage 2, Stage 3). Unfortunately, this means that students of each cohorts exit the school at different times/gates. While I understand that this is inconvenient for some families, we ask for your continued understanding that all procedures follow Department guidelines.

Please ensure you collect your children within the allocated time to their stage. This will aid the success of our cohort groupings.

We strongly recommend that Stage 2 students remain in class until 2.45pm and then meet their parent/carer outside of the school via the main exit to further minimise the mixing of students waiting for collection.

We are also required to restrict access to the school through the locking of all gates between 9am-3pm. Should you need to drop off or collect your child once the gates are locked, please wait at the pedestrian gate at the end of the footpath (closest to office) and call ph: 4325 2181 to have a member of our administration assist you. If you are required to enter the office, you will need to check in using the Service NSW app and provide proof that you are fully immunised from COVID-19.

A friendly reminder to please ensure all items that come to school are labelled with your child's name. Now would also be a great time to check your child has not accidentally taken possession of another child's hat/jumper.

General Reminders

- Please remember to have push notifications turned on for our school app.
- Students must not come to school if they are unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19. Any person who displays symptoms during a school day will be sent home and are not permitted to return from school unless they show proof of a negative COVID test and are symptom free or have isolated for 10 days where no medical certificate is available.

NAPLAN Successes

Now that we are settled into our learning routines, I would like to share the great success that our Year 3 and 5 students had in NAPLAN 2021. We are proud that 46% of students in Year 3 and 34% of students in Year 5 are now achieving in the Top 2 bands for Reading.

In Writing we have 57% of Year 3 students and 36% of Year 5 students achieving Top 2 bands and in Numeracy 25% (Year 3) and 18% (Year 5).

Our students in Year 5 are equal or above the growth level for NSW and we exceeded our Premiers Priority Target by 13% in Reading and 3% in Numeracy.

This is due to the long-standing commitment of our staff in delivering quality education programs as well as our extensive support programs for students who may require a little additional assistance in 1 or more areas.
