Student Reports

All student reports will be distributed next week. Due to the length of time that students participated in learning from home, a modified report approved by the Department of Education will be used. The traditional A-E grading scale will be replaced with a summative comment in English and Mathematics as well as a General Comment.

Please note that the student absences reflect the days missed since faceto-face learning resumed.

While this is a modified report, teachers have spent many hours to ensure that it is a true and accurate reflection of your child's progress. Please take the time to read and discuss the report and reflect on your child's achievements and areas for improvement.



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Tell us what you think survey

Our executive team has now had the opportunity to analyse the *Tell us what you think survey* results and have discussed ways that we can implement strategies from your feedback.

Many families commented that you would like more information about how your child is performing at school and that you prefer face to face contact with teachers. We are hopeful that 2022 will see the return of parent/teacher interviews and community gatherings such as assemblies and the Welcome Back BBQ.

There was also strong feedback that you would like more information about your child's social and emotional growth – while it is a little late for us to modify the Semester 2 reports, we will work hard to include this information in our correspondence for 2022 and beyond.

Other great feedback you have given us includes:

- ✓ 88% of respondents strongly agree or agree that they would feel comfortable speaking to their child's teacher
- ✓ 86% of respondents strongly agree or agree that they would feel comfortable speaking to the principal
- ✓ 98% of respondents strongly agree or agree that written information from the school is in language that can be understood
- ✓ 88% of respondents strongly agree or agree that their child's teacher is interested in their learning
- ✓ 92% of respondents strongly agree or agree that their child's teacher encourages students to do their best work
- ✓ 90% of respondents strongly agree or agree that their child feels safe at school
- ✓ 84% of respondents strongly agree or agree that missing a few days of school has a significant impact on their child's learning
- ✓ 43% of respondents find the app the most helpful way to receive information followed by the newsletter (22%) and SMS (18%)
- ✓ 80% of respondents strongly agree or agree that they would recommend Wyoming Public School to other parents

Wyoming Public School's Annual Presentation of Awards will be held in Stage groups during the last week of term.


As parents are not permitted to attend the presentations the school will provide a memento photograph as well as a celebratory handbook to award recipients.
