Contact with the School

Following feedback from families in 2020 a review of our communication policy has been conducted with the following procedures being put in place for the 2021 school year.

Our school office is open between the hours of 8.30am – 3.30pm (M-F). Please note the phones will not be answered outside these hours.

While we understand that occasionally, the way that a student is getting home may change we are unable to take phone calls regarding this (except for emergency situations) after 2.00pm. Your cooperation ensures there is enough time to communicate messages to those involved.

We strongly encourage all parents to have a conversation with their child each morning about how they are to get home that afternoon to avoid any confusion.

Our school email address is wyoming-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au. We kindly ask that all email correspondence be sent to this email address and not directly to teachers. As our staff are teaching during the school day and often in meetings before and after school we ask for your understanding that emails may take up to 72 hours to respond to. If your matter is urgent in nature we suggest calling the school or writing a note directly to the appropriate person.

School Website and App

In order to streamline the way that we send information to parents (excluding newsletters and notes) our main form of parent updates will be via the school website (https://wyoming-p.schools.nsw.gov.au) and school app (available for android and apple).

A key feature of our website will be the class pages. These will be updated twice a term with important information and an overview of the areas each class is focusing on for the coming weeks.

A new feature will be a photo spread of the school week in review (updated weekly).

As always class notes and current and previous issues of school newsletter will also be available for download. We ask that you refer to this section of the website frequently as solutions to most queries will be found here.

To help support you, become familiar with this new process a push notification will be sent via the app to alert you when key updates are made.

COVID Update

- Students should be at school unless they have a medical certificate which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition and the expected timeframe or they are currently unwell.
- Parents are asked to avoid coming onto school grounds (including the canteen) unless the visit complies with current school guidelines (early departures/late arrivals or pre-arranged meetings with staff). If entering buildings, you will be required to follow our COVID safe procedures (Service NSW QR code and external visitors form) as well as wait outside while the appropriate person/student is located.
- Our Canteen Manager is able to assist students in writing their food orders, alternatively, you can complete a lunch bag at home. Similarly, please contact Annette to arrange 2nd hand uniforms or hats. Where this is not possible the uniform shop will be open between 9.30am-10.30am with parents following all COVID safe procedures (Service NSW QR code and external visitors form).
- Student water fountains and bubblers are now available for student use, however it is preferred that students use refillable water bottles
- If you would like to supply birthday treats to share with your child's class please ensure they are in sealed individual packages (such as a bulk bag of fredo frogs). Please do not send items that you have packaged yourself or homemade goodies. You are also able to purchase a class bucket of iceblocks through our canteen (contact Annette for further details).

School Swimming Carnival:

- The school swimming carnival can proceed without spectators.
- Students must bring food/drinks to the swimming carnival - no canteen facilities will be available.
- Students 12 years and over will be required to wear a mask when travelling on the bus to and from the carnival.

Collection of students at the end of the day:

- Kindergarten students and their siblings can be collected from the hall at 2:30pm following COVID safe procedures (Service NSW QR Code)
- Year 1 and 2 students and their sibling can be collected from the hall at 2:40pm

- following COVID safe procedures (Service NSW QR Code).
- Years 3-6 students can be collected from the hall at 2:45pm following COVID safe procedures (Service NSW QR Code).
- Don't forget-you can also arrange to meet your child outside of school grounds at 2.45pm.
- Please ensure that you adhere to social distancing requirements at all times.
