BEANIE/CAP FUNDRAISER DAY

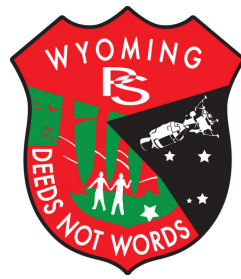
On Wednesday 2 November 2022 Stage 3 representatives, Jett and Ben , are organising a beanie/cap day.
