As we are keen to foster independence in our younger students as well as the leadership skills of our older students, this is a student only event.

The Year 5 and 6 students will run many exciting games and activities, including:

### Cost

Each activity will cost a certain amount of Wyoming Dollars. ### **10: School holiday focus**

#### **Term 4, 1**

**Focus** - Be active: Being active is good for our brains. It helps regulate our emotions and promotes positive mental wellbeing. The focus for this week is to be active! Some suggestions are: at recess and lunch play an active game with friends, when you get home in the afternoon go into your backyard and play a game with your family.

#### **Weeks 2-3**
