

K-2 Areas of Learning - English:

Oral Language and Communication (Talking and Listening)
Understanding texts (Reading)
Creating Texts (Writing)

K-2 Areas of Learning - Mathematics:

Number and algebra Measurement and Space Statistics and probability



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Stage 1, 2 and 3 reports have returned to pre-COVID layout with grades awarded within each subject for individual areas of learning, overall achievement, and overall effort as well as a subject comment and general comment.

Kindergarten reports are graded for effort only and have a comment in each subject area as well as a general comment.

The following definitions are used for each grade:

Outstanding:-The student has an extensive knowledge and understanding of the content and can readily apply this knowledge. In addition, the student has achieved a very high level of competence in the processes and skills and can apply these to new situations.

High:-The student has a thorough knowledge and understanding of the content and a high level of competence in the processes and skills. In addition, the student is able to apply this knowledge and these skills to most situations.

Sound:-The student has a sound knowledge and understanding of the main areas of content and has achieved an adequate level of competence in the processes and skills.

Basic:-The student has a basic knowledge and understanding of the content and has achieved a basic level of competence in the processes and skills.

Limited:-The student has an elementary knowledge and understanding in few areas of the content and has achieved a very limited competence in some of the processes and skills.

Effort grades are:

High:-The student applies a high level of effort towards all aspects of the subject.

Satisfactory:-The student applies a satisfactory level of effort towards all aspects of the subject.

Low:-The student applies a low level of effort towards all aspects of the subject.

Whole and part days absent are also reported on as well as student contribution to areas of school life such as home reading participation.
