****Please note if you need to change the day your child attends Headstart because circumstances have changed since you first enrolled, please either call the school or contact me via Class Dojo.**

Your child's assigned day and time is:

Please come to the pedestrian gate situated on Veronica Close. A staff member will be here to control the number of parents on the school grounds at any one time. You may need to wait for a short period of time before entering the school grounds with your child. We will be allowing one parent/carer to come in to help settle their children but please make this as quick as possible. The maximum time you can stay on school grounds is 10 minutes (as per NSW Department of Education COVID-19 Guidelines). If you can say goodbye without going into the classroom that would be greatly appreciated but we understand this may not be possible for all children. At the end of each session please come to the Veronica Close gate. We will bring the children to you so you don't have to enter the school grounds again.

We have attached a COVID-19 External Visitors to School Site form that all parents must fill in and sign each time they enter the school grounds. I will also attach the form to Class Dojo. If you are able to print it out and fill it in prior to coming each week that will make the drop off process faster. We will have copies on site if this is not possible. We are hoping that after a couple of weeks most children will be happy to walk in from the gate with myself or Sharen Herbert to limit the number of forms you will need to fill in. You will not need a signed form when you pick your child up provided you wait at the gate for us to bring them to you. I know this is often a time where parents ask questions and unfortunately this may not be possible at this time. Please direct any questions or concerns you may have via Class Dojo messages or call the school and leave a message with the front office and I will return your call. **Remember to utilise the hand sanitiser at the sign on table and practice social distancing at all times.**

Headstart Parent Information Sessions will not be run due to current restrictions. We will endeavour to give you as much information through handouts, Class Dojo, the Headstart Website and our school website to support you and your child's preparation and transition to school.

You will find a reminder attached regarding documentation the school requires and a timeline for submission.
