### **Personalised Learning and Support Plans:**

At Wyoming Public School student learning is catered for through the development of a Personalised Learning and Support Plan (PLaSP). The home reading scheme will commence shortly. Please read the book to your child or have them read it to you. Books can be returned throughout the week and will be swapped for a new one.

### **Homework**

Homework will be sent home on Monday afternoon and will be due in on the following Monday morning.

**Fruit Break:**

3-6S has a fruit break every day at 10am. Please ensure that your child has a piece of fruit or fresh vegetables.

**Personal belongings**

Please label all your child's property, especially hats, jumpers and drink bottles. Water bottles are encouraged as the children may have them on their desks to drink as they need.

**Scripture:**

Scripture is scheduled for Wednesday afternoons on a fortnightly basis (odd weeks). Information will be sent home shortly.


**Excursions:**
