English

Students will be taught comprehension skills using the *Focus on Reading* program and writing will follow the *Seven Steps to Writing Success* program. Each term there will be a major literature study. This year the quality texts will be: *Iggy Peck Architect, Simpson and his Donkey, Fantastic Mr Fox* and *Misery Guts*.

Maths

All students take part in the Basic Maths Program, this program teaches facts for the four operations $+ - x \div$. All students will also take part in daily multiplication practice using the *Big Ideas in Number* techniques. This is a different way of teaching times tables – contact your class teacher if you would like specific information on this.

Book Work

In Stage 2 students will be provided with the following books - Reading, Spelling, Writing, Maths, Geography & History, Science & Technology and a workbook. Special covers have been purchased to cover these books.

Assembly

Due to COVID, no school assemblies have been scheduled as yet.

Scripture

Each 'odd' week (Weeks 1, 3, 5 etc) our school has scripture. There are three groups: Catholic, Combined and non-scripture. If you would like your child to change their attendance in one of these groups, please contact the school in writing.

Home Reading

Each child will receive a home reading log. Students are provided with books to read at their level of skill as determined by teacher assessment. Students that are at a 30+ Benchmark level are 'independent readers' who can choose their own books from the library. Students need to fill in their log and have a parent sign it. Discussing the book with your child and asking questions will help with the comprehension development that is being taught at school.
