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Welcome to 3P (Stage 2, Year 3) – Ms Kelsi Phillips

It has been an exciting week meeting and getting to know each student in 3P. For those families I have not yet met, my name is Kelsi Phillips. I promote a classroom of creativity and collaborative learning where students are encouraged to ask questions, think critically and try their personal best in every aspect of their education. The list below will help you prepare for the year ahead.

Absences: It is a legal requirement that families explain a child's absence from school within one week of the absence. The free Wyoming Public School app has an option to message the school regarding absences, or you can send a note. Any leave (short or long term or partial i.e. part of a day) please provide a letter informing the school of your child's upcoming leave prior to period of absence. Late arrivals and early departures need to see office staff to be signed in/out.

Communication: If you need to discuss your child with me, please call and leave a message with the office and I will contact you outside classroom hours. If it is more convenient you can email the front office (wyoming-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au) and they will forward your message to me.

Equipment:

In Stage 2 we encourage our students to take responsibility for their belongings. Students are asked to bring the following items to class:

- pencil case
- lead pencils
- eraser
- coloured pencils
- scissors
- textas
- box of tissues for class
- ruler – 30cm long; *no bendy, metal or folding rulers please*
- glue stick
- sharpener
- Old shirt or t-shirt to protect uniform during Art lessons

Creative and Performing Arts is every Monday morning with Mrs Nicole Carter.

Home Reading is expected to occur at least four days each week. Home reading will be checked every morning and students who read will accumulate tokens. These tokens help students obtain a principal's award and attend the principal's award afternoon.

Homework will be supplied weekly and is due on Friday. Students are encouraged to try each activity. If, however, there are areas of difficulty students may circle the question and hand it in on Friday.

Library is every Wednesday with Mrs Surinda Walton. Borrowing and returning library books will happen during this session. In order to protect library books students are only permitted to borrow when they bring a light bag– the Books in Homes bag makes an ideal library bag.

Medical: Please contact the office to ensure your paperwork is current; this includes allergies, anaphylaxis, asthma, medication and other health plans. If your child is asthmatic, please ensure the school has a current copy of your child's Asthma Action Plan, as completed on the appropriate form by your doctor and that the reliever kept by the office is in date.

Sport will take place every Friday. Hats are compulsory.
