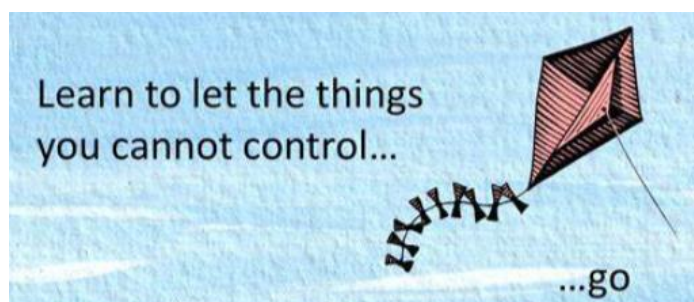
Work packs will be available through the usual process - don't forget to bring along any completed work that you have.
