Rainbow Run for Fun

Dear parents and caregivers

Students at Wyoming Public School will be participating in a Rainbow Run for Fun (Colour Run) to support the wellbeing programs of the school on **Thursday 28 April 2022**.

Participation in the run is free of charge to students.

Optional colour merchandise is available for purchase to support Year 6 Fundraising. The P&C will also be organising fundraising food and drink options. Separate correspondence will be sent home regarding this.

Quality Colour Powder Pty Ltd has been used to supply powder made of cornflower/corn-starch and synthetic food dye. A Safety Data Sheet is available to parents on request.

Special requirements:

- Students are to come to school dressed in light coloured, sun safe clothes and enclosed shoes (no singlets or mid-drift tops)
- Students are asked to bring sunscreen and apply before the run
- Students may wish to bring goggles/sunglasses to protect eyes from powder
- We recommended that students with respiratory conditions (e.g., asthma) wear a mask – these can be provided
- Students with light coloured hair may wish to apply hair conditioner or olive oil to their hair to prevent it from being coloured
- Students are encouraged to pack a towel to sit on during transport home to avoid colour transfer

Please note that items including shoes may become stained by the colour powder used.

Organisation:

12.30pm – Parents and families invited to join with students under the COLA and on the concrete areas for a picnic lunch - Please note entry will be via Maidens Brush Road administration pedestrian gate only.

1.10pm – Students will assemble under the COLA in class groups. Parents are asked to move to the designated viewing area

1.15pm – Event commences with students completing the course supervised by staff

2.30pm – Event concludes with whole school “dance off.” Families will be invited to join their children for the last dance, photos, and fun

We ask that all children remain at school until 2.30pm. After this time students may leave with their parents while all other students assemble under the COLA for normal dismissal procedures.

Please note that this event is for current families of Wyoming Public School only. Older siblings who are High School age or siblings who attend a different school are not permitted.

Students who do not wish to participate in the “colour” part of the day will have the option to join in the obstacle course. Some colour transfer from equipment may still occur.

Representing Wyoming Public School at an out of school event is a privilege for students who follow the school Welfare and Discipline Policy. Any student who does not follow this policy will be withdrawn at the discretion of the Principal and Executive Team. Generally, this will include any student who receives 2 or more detentions, a suspension or any incident involving aggressive behaviour in the 4 weeks prior to the event.

Privacy Advice
