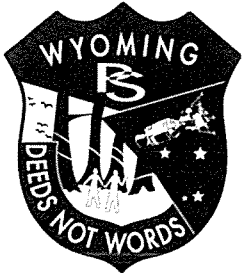
Students are to be dressed in full school uniform and are required to bring:
