Kindergarten Excursion Change of Venue

Dear parent or caregiver,

Due to unforeseen circumstances, we have changed the venue of the kindergarten excursion on Wednesday 14 September to Golden Ridge Animal Farm. This excursion has been planned to supplement work being completed in the Key Learning Area of Science.

Students will experience a variety of farm experiences including holding baby animals, milking a cow, feed sheep and goats.

There is no additional cost for families who have already paid - please return the attached consent form by Wednesday 7 September.

We can now accept a small number of additional students. If you had not previously paid but would like you child to attend, please return the permission note and \$35.00 payment (cash or POP) by Wednesday 7 September. *No payments will be accepted after this date.*

Students are required to arrive at school no later than 8.30am. the coach will be departing promptly at 9.00am. We will not be able to wait for any late arrivals. We will return to Wyoming Public School at approximately 2.30pm so that students can follow their normal afternoon travel arrangements home. Accompanying classroom teachers are Emily Marsh and Megan O'Riley plus additional support staff.

Representing Wyoming Public School at an out of school event is a privilege for students who follow the school Welfare and Discipline Policy. Any student who does not follow this policy will be withdrawn at the discretion of the Principal and Executive Team. As a general rule, this will include any student who receives 2 or more detentions, a suspension or any incident involving aggressive behaviour during the term.

Students are to be dressed in full school uniform and are required to bring:

- School hat
- Recess & a drink
- Lunch & a drink

Please place recess/drink in one disposable bag and lunch/drink in another disposable bag. Each bag should be labelled with your child's name and class.
