Dear parent or caregiver,

Students of 3P, 3R, 4H and 4L will be participating in an excursion to Gosford Waterfront on Tuesday 29 November 2022.

This excursion has been planned to supplement work being completed in the following Key Learning Areas / Topics:

- Geography – Places are Similar and Different

We will be visiting Gosford CBD and the waterfront to discuss and design potential re-development of these areas. Students will be utilising maps, drawing designs, and discussing changes for this urban zone.

The cost for the excursion is \$7 (transport).

Full payment must be made to the office by Wednesday 23 November 2022.

Students will depart from school at 9:15am and return to school at 2.45pm. Please ensure your child is at school for the usual roll call time so we can leave promptly.

Accompanying staff are Mr Walter, Mrs Lenton, Miss Phillips, Mrs Rio and Mrs Walker.

Representing Wyoming Public School at an out of school event is a privilege for students who follow the school Welfare and Discipline Policy. Any student who does not follow this policy will be withdrawn at the discretion of the Principal and Executive Team. As a general rule this will include any student who receives 2 or more detentions, a suspension or any incident involving aggressive behaviour within two weeks of the excursion.

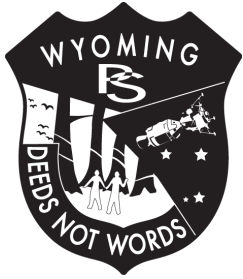
Students are to be dressed in full school uniform and are required to bring:
