Excursion Information: Stage 1 The Art House, Wyong

Dear parent or caregiver

Stage 1 students will be participating in an excursion to The Art House, Wyong to see a live theatre production on Tuesday 21 March 2023.

The show is adapted from the award winning picture book 'Are we there yet' by Alison Lester.

This excursion has been planned to supplement work being completed in the Key Learning Area of English.

Travel will be by bus.

The cost for the excursion is \$25

PAYMENT: Due Friday 3 March 2023.

Tickets are strictly limited so please be prompt.

Payment with Service NSW Back to School Vouchers:

The Premier's Back to School NSW Program provides 3 x \$50 vouchers, totalling \$150 for each eligible student. The stage 1 excursion is an eligible expense to claim a voucher. Please advise in the payment section of the permission note if you wish to claim a voucher and someone from the office will be in contact with you. Please note by claiming a voucher this will mean you will forfeit \$25 as the balance cannot be used in another transaction. No refunds can be claimed for the excursion if you redeem with a voucher.

Departure

All students will need to be at school at 8:45am. Students will leave their bags in their classroom bag area and then meet the teachers in the basement area. We will be leaving at 9am. **Please be on time.** We will not be waiting for any late students.

Return

We will return to school before 12pm. Students will make their way home as per normal arrangements.

Recess and Lunches

We will not be taking any recess or lunch. We will return for a late recess.

Wet Weather

The excursion will proceed no matter what the weather.

School Uniform

Students are to be dressed in full school uniform.

Important information

In the event of injury, no personal injury insurance cover is provided by the NSW Department of Education for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. The Department's public liability cover is fault-based and limited to breaches by the Department of its duty of care to students that may result in claims for compensation.

Parents/Carers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child/ward's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school sport zone, region and state school sport associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover is required prior to their child's involvement in the program. Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail outlets.

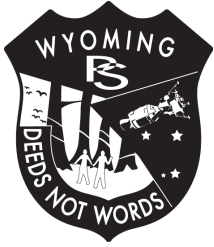
Parents/Carers who have private ambulance cover need to check whether that cover extends to interstate travel and make additional arrangements as considered appropriate.

The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty or the loss of use of certain prescribed parts of the body. I further acknowledge that, should this occur, my child/ward will only be permitted to participate in the event, if a medical clearance is provided. (Concussion statement)
- I affirm that, to the best of my knowledge, my child/ward has no medical condition or injury that places him/her at risk by participating in this sport activity.
- In the event of any accident or illness, I authorise the obtaining, on my behalf, of an ambulance and any such medical assistance that my child/ward may require. I accept full responsibility for expenses incurred.

Privacy Advice

The information provided on this form is being obtained for the purpose of ascertaining relevant medical information, requirements and other health care related needs about students who are currently enrolled at Wyoming Public School and who are participating in school excursions, sporting activities or other educational or school activities.

It will be used by officers of the NSW Department of Education and Training to assist planning, to support students, and to minimise risks when conducting school excursions, sporting or other school activities.

Other persons or agencies that may be provided with this information include, but are not limited to, volunteers and members of external organisations who join with the school or are otherwise involved in the planning or delivery of the excursion, sporting or other school activity; and persons that may be called upon to provide health care treatment or other assistance during or as a consequence of such excursions or activities.

Provision of this information is not required by law. However, a failure to provide the information may mean that your child can not participate in a particular excursion or school activity. In such circumstances the school will make available a sound alternative educational experience.

Provision of this information will significantly assist the school in planning a safer educational activity. It will be stored securely. If you have any concerns about provision of this information, please contact the school principal to discuss further.
