Excursion Information: Fort Scratchley, Newcastle

Dear parent or caregiver

Students of Stage 2 will be participating in an excursion to Fort Scratchley, Newcastle on Thursday 30 March 2023. Fort Scratchley was built in the 1880s to prepare Australia for a possible attack. The Fort became operational again in 1942 during WWII. Today, the Fort is a historical museum.

This excursion has been planned to supplement work being completed in the following Key Learning Areas / Topics:

☐ History – Community & Remembrance

The cost for the excursion is \$40.

To assist with budgeting payments, the following payment plan may be utilised:

- \$ 15 deposit with return of consent form by 9 March 2023.
- \$ 15 no later than 16 March 2023.
- \$ 10 no later than 23 March 2023.

DEADLINE FOR FULL PAYMENT: Thursday 23 March 2023 (date of final payment plan date). No payments will be accepted after this date.

If you are experiencing financial difficulty an application to receive assistance for a single payment plan amount may be requested through the principal in the week prior to the payment being due.

Students will depart from Wyoming Public School at 8am and return to school at approximately 3pm. Travel will be by bus.
